BY-LAW NO. 6420

A By-law to amend By-law No. 3575, being the Zoning and Development By-law

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- The "Zoning District Plan" annexed to By-law No. 3575 as Schedule "D" is hereby amended according to the plan marginally numbered Z-352a and attached to this By-law as Schedule "A", and in accordance with the explanatory legends, notations and references inscribed thereon, so that the boundaries and districts shown on the Zoning District Plan are varied, amended or substituted to the extent shown on Schedule "A" of this By-law, and Schedule "A" of this By-law is hereby incorporated as an integral part of Schedule "D" of By-law No. 3575.
- The area shown included within the heavy black outline on Schedule "A" is rezoned to CD-1, and the only uses permitted within the said area, subject to such conditions as Council may by resolution prescribe, and the only uses for which development permits will be issued are:
 - (a) maximum of 185 dwelling units;
 - (b) commercial, provided that this use does not exceed 3,288.766 m² (35,400 sq. ft.);
 - (c) social, recreational and cultural:
 - (d) accessory uses customarily ancillary to the above uses.

3 Floor Space Ratio

The maximum floor space ratio, computed in accordance with the applicable provisions of the West End District Official Development Plan, shall be 6.00, except that amenity areas for the social and recreational enjoyment of the residents, or providing a service to the public, including facilities for general fitness, or recreation, and day care are excluded from the floor space measurement, provided that:

- (i) the total area being excluded shall not exceed the lesser of 20 percent of the permitted floor space, or 929.03 m² (10,000 sq. ft.); and
- (ii) in the case of a child day care centre, the Director of Planning, on the advice of the Director of Social Planning, is satisfied of a need for the facility in the immediate neighbourhood.
- Where exterior walls greater than 152 mm in thickness have been recommended by a Building Envelope Professional as defined in the Building By-law, the area of the walls exceeding 152 mm, but to a maximum exclusion of 152 mm thickness, shall be excluded in the computation of floor space ratio, except that this section shall not apply to walls in existence prior to March 14, 2000. - 4 Height

The maximum building height, measured above the base surface, shall be 85.34 m (280 ft.).

5 Off-Street Parking

Off-street parking shall be provided, developed and maintained in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Parking By-law, except that a minimum of 338 off-street parking spaces shall be provided.

6 Off-Street Loading

Off-street loading shall be provided, developed and maintained in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Parking By-law.
